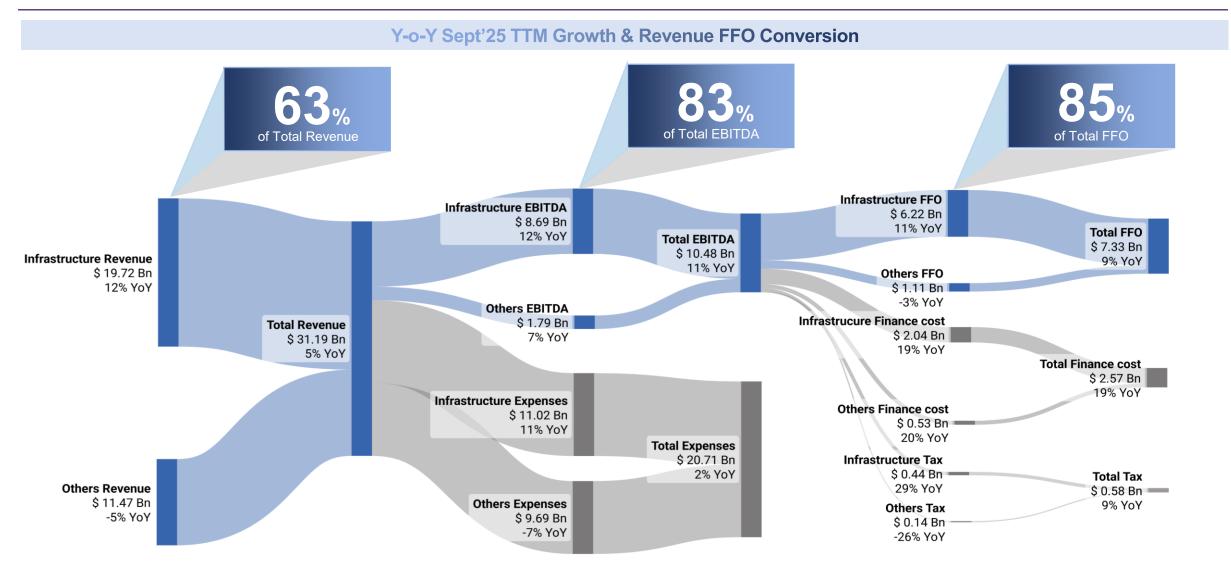

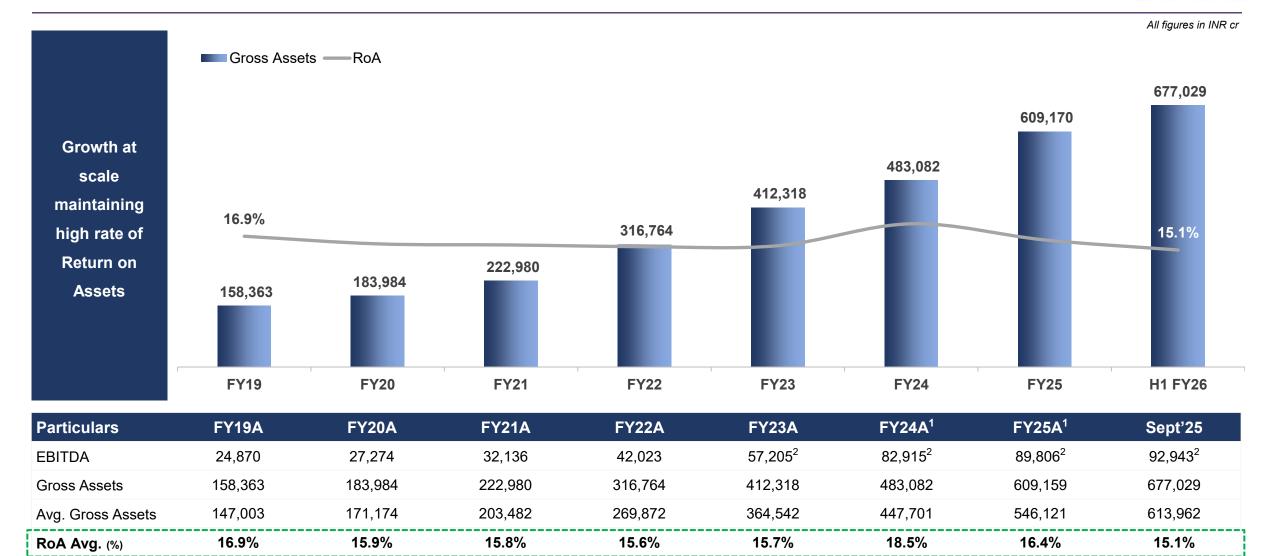

Adani Portfolio: Maintaining RoA at rapidly increasing Asset base



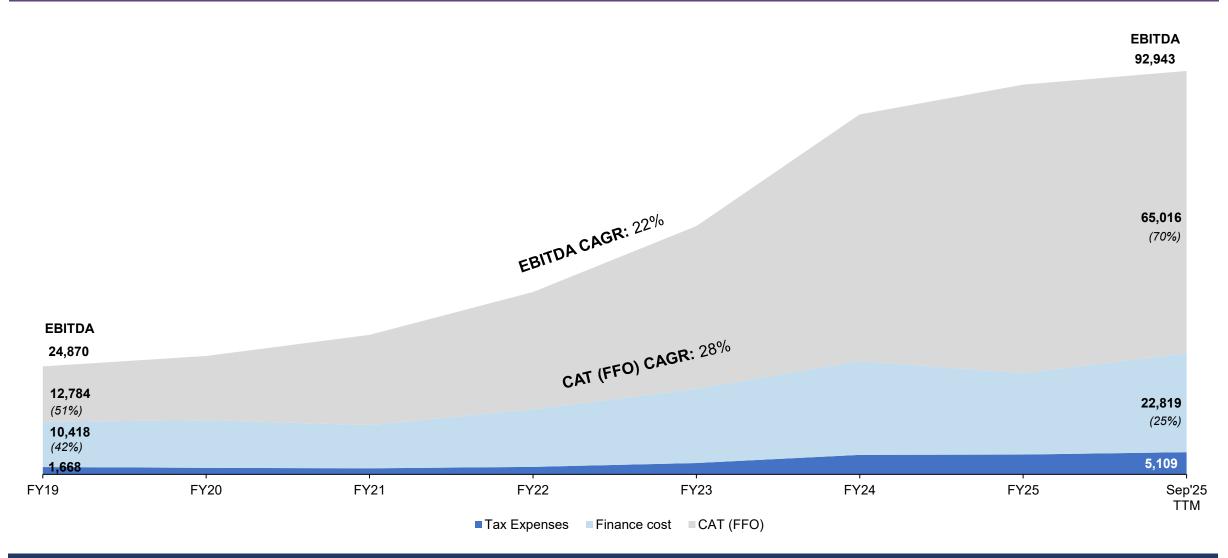

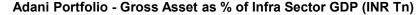

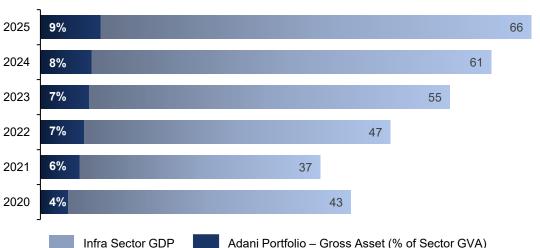

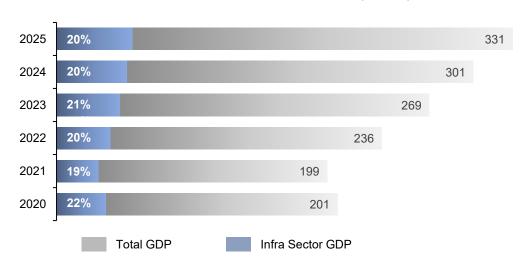

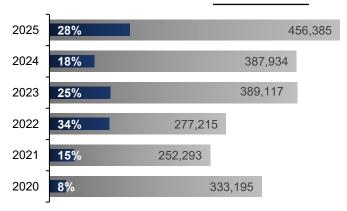




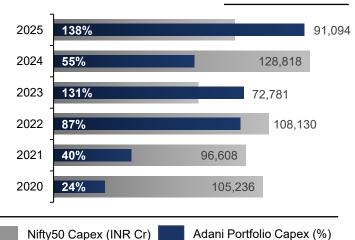
Infra Sector GDP as % of Total GDP (INR Tn)



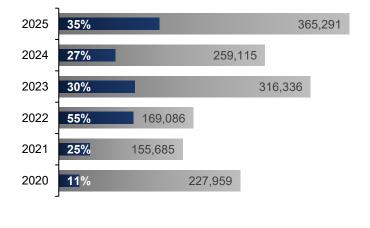
Adani Portfolio – Capex as % of Nifty50 Capex



Adani Portfolio – Capex as % of Nifty50 PSU Capex

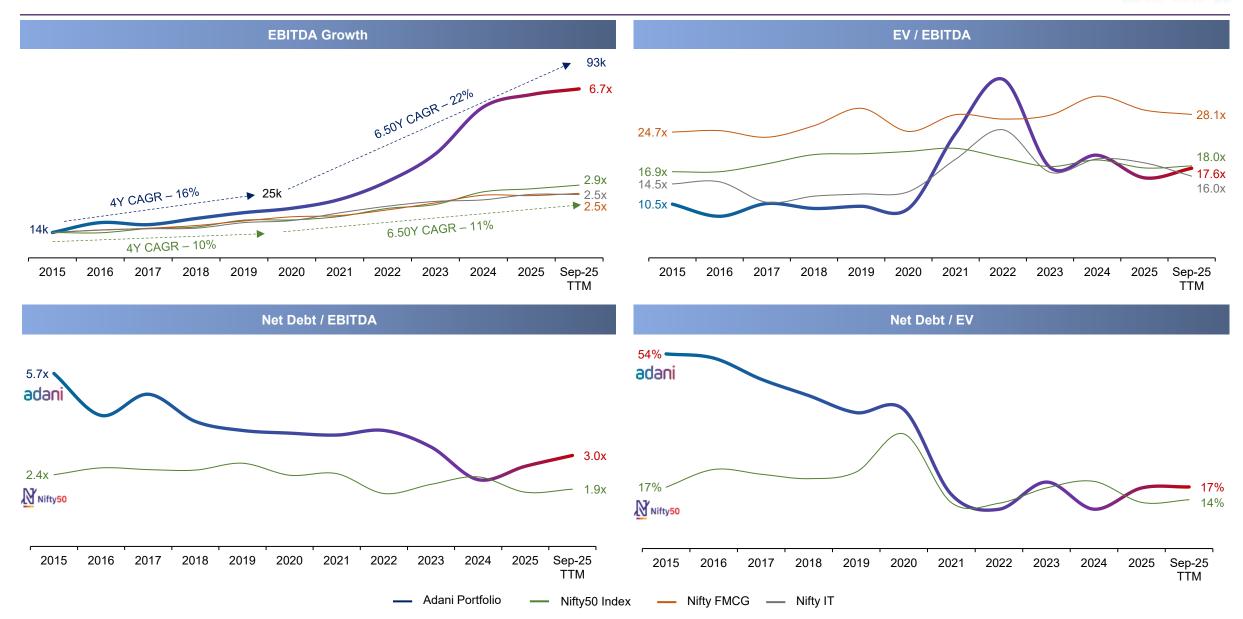


Adani Portfolio – Capex as % of Nifty50 Private Capex

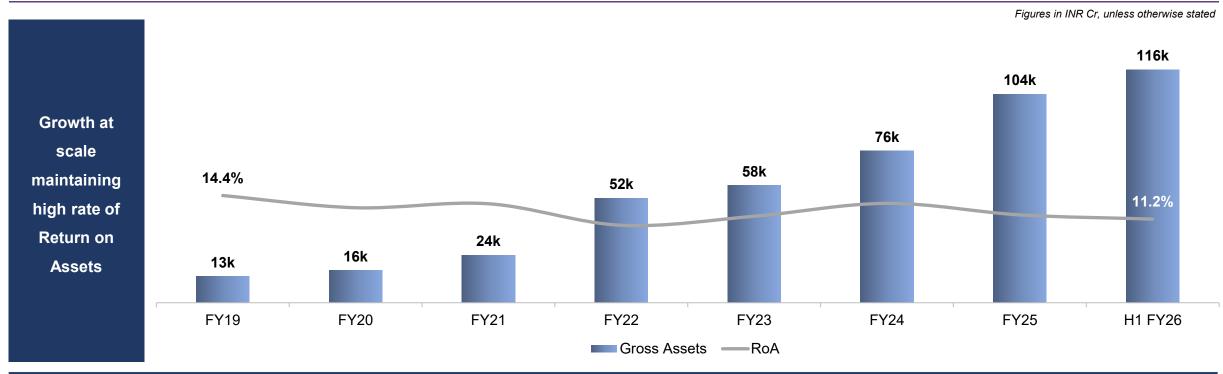

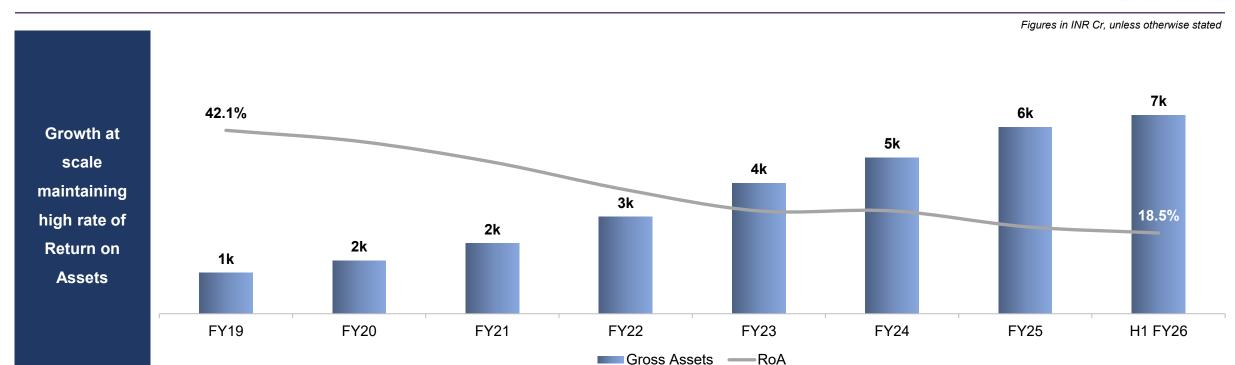

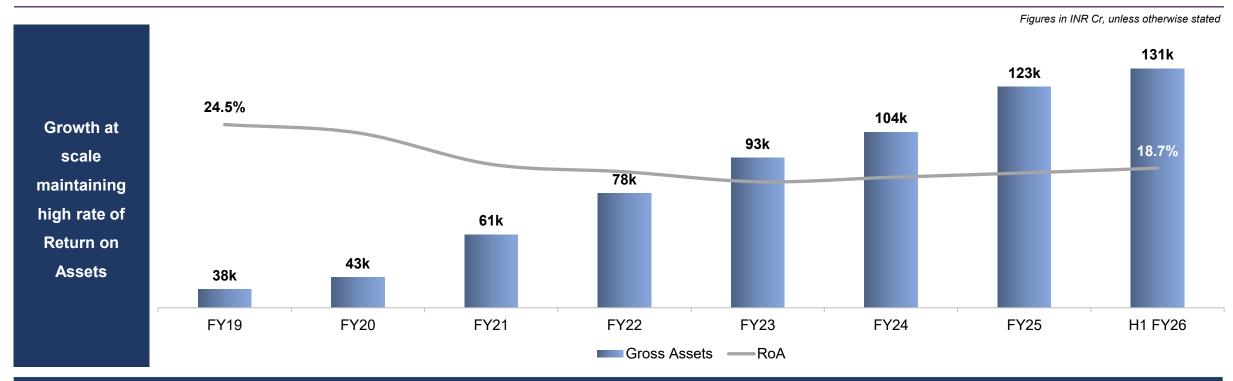

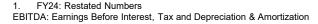

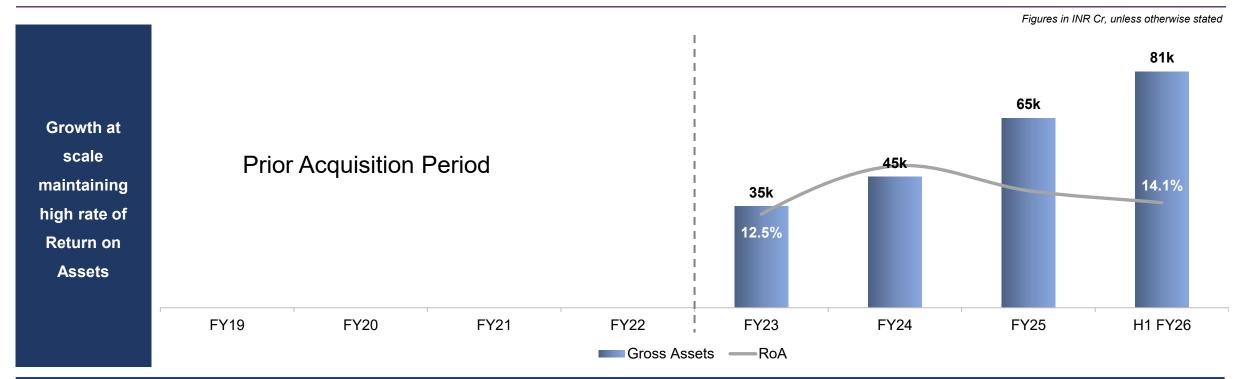

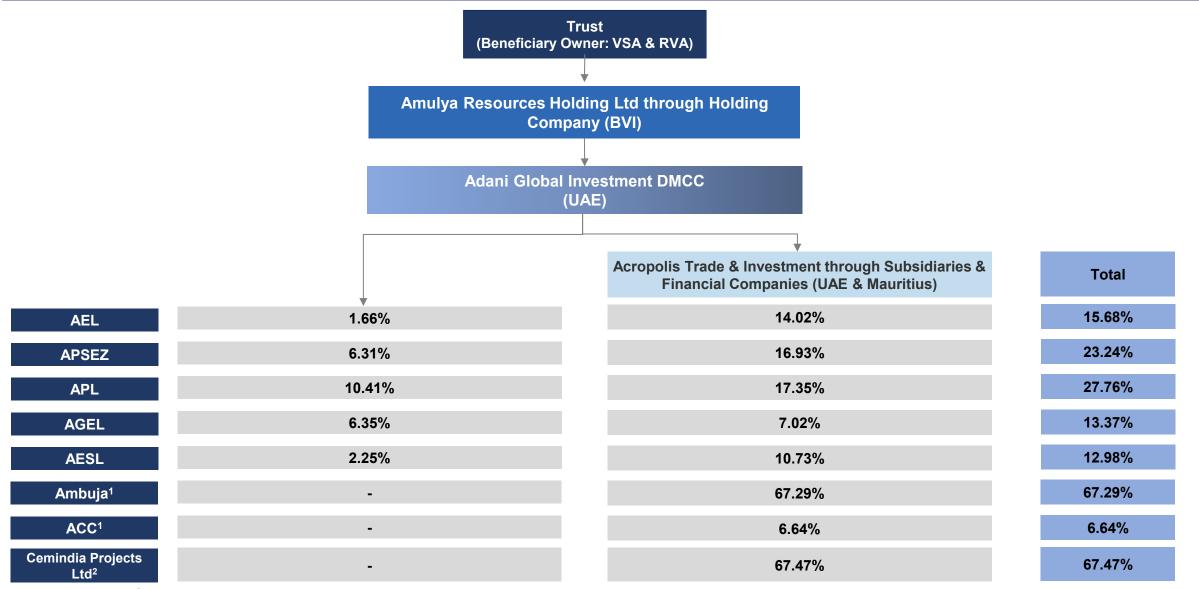

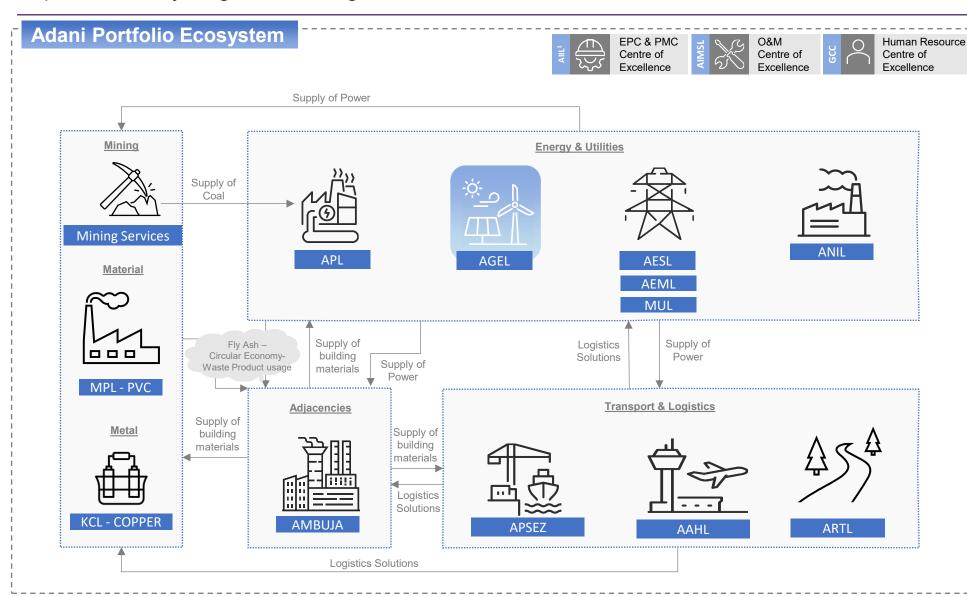
