CID to write to Interpol over Gandhinagar man's death on US border

DAYS AFTER the reported death of a Kalol resident while trying to cross the US-Mexico border, the Crime Investigation Department (CID) Gandhinagar Monday decided to write to the Interpol seeking more details about his death and his family members.

According to media reports from Mexico, Brijkumar Yadav, 38, who works as an accountant in a private firm in Kalol, had allegedly fallen to death while scaling a wall on the US-Mexico border near Tijuana, sometime before December 15.

Yadav was accompanied by his wife Pooja and their three-year-old son Tanmay while crossing to US, the report said.

The family had gone to Mexico on a tourist visa, Additional DGP (CID, Crime and Railways) RB Brahmabhatt told The Indian Express Monday.

Brahmabhatt said that Yadav's wife Pooja is in San Diego, while their son is in a hospital in Tijuana.

"We have got the passport detail of Brijkumar Yadav, his wife, Pooja, and their son. We are going to write to the International Criminal Police Organization (Interpol), on these details on Monday," he added.

Yadav's sister-in-law Sushila, had told this paper Saturday that the family had left on November 18, saying they were "going on a trip". They last heard from Pooja on December 17, saying her husband had died of a heart attack.

Yadav was a resident of Chhatral area near Kalol in Gandhinagar and hails from Pathak Purwa village in Uttar Pradesh's Gonda district.

Brijkumar earned a monthly salary of Rs 15,000 and Pooja as a teacher at a private school for Rs 20,000 a month.

"CID is the nodal agency to intimate with the Interpol in such cases," said Brahmabhatt, adding they were doing the "preliminary enquiry".

"All we know is that the family went to Mexico on tourist visa. The investigation is still going on," he added. Interpol assists law enforcement agencies in each of its 195 member countries to combat all forms of transnational crime.

been "seriously preparing for such exams."

In its report, the commission has highlighted the need to fill up the vacancies immediately in various departments.

"Because of insufficient staff, the day-to-day works of the departments may suffer to the large extent... It is learnt that in many of the departments, additional charge is given to the employees/officials because of lack of staff."

The commission has noted that large number of youths graduates from the colleges in Gujarat, but they do not get opportunity to serve the state government. In this context, the commission added that in many colleges/universities, private companies/corporate sector offer jobs to the youths at the end of final semester.

"Lakhs of youths have been deprived of jobs because of scams during exams. Cancellation of exams may break down the morale of the youths affected by unemployment," it added.

The commission has cited four examples of allegations of paper leaks or other irregularities in government examinations.

It included Lok Rakshak Dal recruitment of December 2018, head clerk recruitment of December 2021, engineers' re-

cruitment in Gujarat Energy Transmission Corporation in January 2022, forest guards' recruitment in March 2022.

The commission added that there are many more such incidents which are known to all.

In one of its observations to have a special law to deal with the paper leak menace, the Commission has recorded, "...one of the reasons behind paper leaks may be corruption due to the involvement of influential people in the State Government but unfortunately, they are never caught... It is said that the big fish always escapes the law, while those who get caught are mostly ordinary people."

In an observation related to the issue, the Commission recorded, "When the incidences of paper leak come to the notice of the people, question must be raised on the State Government's intention in conducting impartial and clean recruitment through competitive exams."

Recommending to have a special law, the Commission reported, "...the issue needs to be resolved as expeditiously as possible and, therefore, this Commission recommends for introduction of a special law against 'paper leak'."

It has also recommended examining similar law in Haryana. Legislative and parliamentary affairs minister Rushikesh Patel could not be contacted despite repeated attempts.

Paper leak in the government recruitment examinations was one of the issues raised by Congress and Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) in the recently concluded Gujarat assembly elections. Both the opposition parties had also

made a poll promise to bring a special law to check the menace of paper leak.

COLD WAVE CONDITIONS AT ISOLATED POCKETS IN KUTCH

Winter sets in with a delay in state, Naliya records 5.8 degrees Celsius

Winter has set in albeit with a delay in Gujarat with minimum temperature dropping to 5.8 degrees Celsius in Naliya, which was the coldest district in the state on Monday where the temperature was six degrees below normal.

Cold wave conditions were reported at isolated pockets in Kutch district as northeasterly winds are prevailing at lower levels over the region, and the condition is likely to continue Tuesday, according to the India Meteorological Department (IMD).

Other centres with minimum temperature below 10 degrees Celsius were Patan and Deesa.

Bhuj recorded 10 degrees Celsius, Rajkot 10.2 and

Gandhinagar recorded 11.7, Kandla and Porbandar 13, Ahmedabad 13.2, Bhavnagar 13.9, Surat 14.1, Vadodara 14.4, Dwaraka 15.2 and Veraval 15.3 recorded degrees Celsius.

After long, the maximum

temperature also dropped to below 30 degrees Celsius across the state with the lowest being recorded at Okha (25 degrees Celsius) while the highest was 29.8 degrees Celsius in Surat and Mahuva.

8-year-old dies after iron gate falls on her at Dahod school

Dahod: An eight-year-old died after an iron gate fell on her at a government school in Dahod, an official said on Monday. While the incident took place at a primary school in Rampura village on December 20, the victim died of head injuries at a hospital in Ahmedabad Friday, the official said.

A heavy iron gate on the school compound came off the hinges and fell on the victim Ashmita Mohani when she was playing near it, district primary education officer Mayur Parekh said.

The girl sustained serious head injuries and was taken to a private hospital in Dahod city, and was later shifted to Ahmedabad civil hospital, where she died during treatment Friday, he said. Following the incident, the school's principal was suspended with immediate effect, Parekh said.

A case of accidental death was registered at Dahod rural police station and further probe was launched, a police official. PTI
