NCERT row: 'Blacklisted' scholars move Supreme Court

THREE PROMINENT academics—Michel Danino, Suparna Diwakar, and Alok Prasanna Kumar—have approached the Supreme Court seeking to vacate a “blacklisting” order issued against them. The order followed the court’s suo motu cognisance of a Class 8 NCERT social science textbook chapter discussing “corruption” in the judiciary.

Senior Advocates Arvid Datar, appearing for Danino; J Sai Deepak for Diwakar; and Gopal Sankaranarayanan for Kumar, told a bench of CJI Surya Kant and Justice Joyymya Bagchi that they had filed their affidavits as well as applications seeking a hearing late Saturday evening. The bench, however, said the applications were yet to be listed before it and would hear them once they are listed, after curing any defects, if any.

The SC had taken suo motu cognisance of the matter following a report in *The Indian Express* on February 24 and sought responses from NCERT and the Centre. Hearing it on March 11, the court directed the Centre, state and Union Territory governments, all universities, and public institutions receiving government funds “to dissociate with” the three academics involved in the preparation of the book.

While the court imposed the restriction, it allowed the scholars to seek modification of the order with a formal explanation. “We have filed our affidavits where we have given our explanation because the observations that have come in your previous two orders have, apart from directing blacklisting of us for the future, also cast some grave doubts about our learning and knowledge, etc. We have filed applications as well...”, Sankaranarayanan told the bench and requested the court to hear them. The CJI asked, “Are you defending your action?”

Sankaranarayanan said, “We are giving a context, and we are showing your lordships the new pedagogy that has come in from the National Education Policy, including how other issues, because I was present that day, *The Indian Express* article was shown to your lordships, saying that the judiciary has been singled out...”

He added, “These are not fly-by-night academics... The author (Alok Prasanna), in fact, has appeared before your lordships, has been an advocate of this court. Once that is placed, your lordships may consider it,” Sankaranarayanan submitted.

Displaced in Manipur conflict, 7-year-old girl found dead

Imphal: The body of a seven-year-old girl, who had been living at a relief camp for the last three years, was found in Imphal East district of Manipur on Monday, police said.

A 28-year-old man, Laishram Langamba (28), has been arrested in the case, they added. Later in the day, enraged IDPs from the relief camp where the girl lived staged a protest outside the local police station, demanding death penalty for the accused. The protest escalated into a confrontation with security personnel, prompting police to fire tear gas shells to disperse the crowd. The girl had been residing in the relief camp after ethnic tension broke out on May 3, 2023.

Officials said the minor had been missing since Sunday. After she failed to return home till late in the night, the family lodged a formal missing person complaint after which teams from Imphal East and Imphal West launched a coordinated search operation. Police examined CCTV footage from nearby areas, which led to the identification of a suspect and his detention for questioning. Police said that during interrogation, the accused confessed to have killed the girl. He led police to the spot where the body of the girl was recovered in a sack under a bridge. The body has been kept at the mortuary of a hospital for post-mortem examination.

Kerala, Centre back 2018 Sabarimala judgment review; hearing in SC today

IN CONTRAST to its earlier stand, Kerala’s ruling Left Democratic Front government on Monday backed pleas for review of the Supreme Court’s 2018 Sabarimala judgment that removed the age restrictions on entry of women to the hill shrine.

The Advocate on Record for the Kerala government, Nishe Rajen Shonker, in a letter to nodal counsel for the review petitioners Advocate Krishna Kumar Singh said that the state in its written submissions, “is supporting the case of the Review Petitioner” and requested that its name be therefore “included on the side of the Review Petitioner and to grant time of one hour to address arguments so as to assist the Hon’ble Court

on the issues involved”.

The letter comes a day ahead of Tuesday’s scheduled hearing by a nine-Judge Constitutional Bench of constitutional questions arising out of the review petitions.

Meanwhile, the Centre, too, in written submissions filed Monday opposed the 2018 Sabarimala judgment saying it has “several ... errors which are apparent on the face of the record”. The submissions by Solicitor General Tushar Mehta said that “in the Sabarimala judgment” the majority “opinions not only wrongly declared Ayyapan devotees not to fall within the definition of ‘denomination’ but failed to even deal with the expression ‘or a section thereof’”.

This, the Centre said, “assumes particular importance in the Indian context because religions in India, especially Hin-

In written submissions filed on March 14, the Kerala government called for “wide consultations” before any change is made to the “religious practice followed for so many years”. This was interpreted as a significant climbdown given that the state had earlier supported the September 28, 2018, decision of a five-Judge bench to allow the entry of all women, irrespective of their age, to the temple.

dualism, are marked by deep internal diversity. Hinduism has historically accommodated

multiple streams of thought, forms of worship, ritual practices, local traditions, philosophical schools, temple traditions and ‘sampradayas’ and even village deities. Therefore, constitutional adjudication must account for plurality within religion and not proceed on the assumption that every religion has only one uniform set of beliefs and practices”.

The government said that “so far as ‘Hinduism’ is concerned, almost all previous judgments have fallen into error by considering ‘Hinduism’ per se as a ‘denomination’ without examining the vastness, depth and width of what is included in Hinduism by the very unique nature of its features”.

Underlining the diversity of Hinduism, Mehta said that “the religious practice of restricting the entry of women aged 10-50

to Sabarimala is rooted in the unique nature of the deity, i.e., Lord Ayyappa, who is worshipped in the form of a Naisthika Brahmachari (eternal celibate). The exclusion is not rooted in notions of impurity or inferiority of women but flows from the very character and the attribute of the deity being worshipped. Permitting entry would fundamentally alter the nature and character of worship at this particular temple, thereby undermining rather than advancing public morality in the context of religious pluralism, a value the Constitution itself protects. The public interest would then lie in preserving the rich diversity of religious practices across the country rather than imposing a single, homogenised standard of worship on all temples”

SC backs Wayanad tunnel project, refuses to cancel green clearance

THE SUPREME COURT Monday refused to interfere with the Kerala High Court order rejecting the challenge to the Environment Clearance (EC) to the twin-tunnel project through the Western Ghats linking Wayanad and Kozhikode districts in the state.

A bench of Chief Justice of India Surya Kant and Justice Joyymya Bagchi said the project is of national importance and that the clearance has adequate safeguards, which, if implemented effectively, will ensure the project’s safety. The bench added that, in the event of any violation of the conditions, the petitioners can approach the National Green Tribunal (NGT).

“We find...from...the impugned judgment of the High Court and the report of the Central Expert Appraisal Committee that the approval was accorded to the project subject to various conditions. What is more important is that, while executing the project, the project proponent must meticulously comply with the conditions,” the bench said.

“The High Court rightly felt that if any condition is not followed, in that event, the peti-

tioners can approach the National Green Tribunal, as such a violation can amount to accrual of a fresh cause of action. In view of the liberty granted by the High Court, we see no reason to interfere with the judgment of the High Court. The petitioners will beat liberty to approach the NGT during the execution of the project, if so needed, in terms of the liberty granted by the High Court,” it added.

Appearing for the appellant, the original petitioner before the Kerala High Court, Wayanad Prakrithi Samrakshana Samithi, Senior Advocate Shyam Divan said the area where the project is being undertaken is prone to landslides, the latest of which was in 2024 and killed hundreds of people besides causing other destruction. Divan contended that the environmental impact assessment of the project ought to have been undertaken at the central level, rather than at the state level.

However, the bench noted that experts had examined it.

Divan argued that the high court’s findings were not correct. “The High Court has merely said that these are technical matters. Then at least, the technical procedure must be followed. That has not been done.”

SMALL DONATIONS, BIG AUCTIONS

An egg sold for Rs 6,000, apple for Rs 1.05 lakh: How Ladakh is contributing to Iran relief efforts

IN THE Kaksar village of Kargil, a woman turned up outside a mosque last week to donate three hens — her contribution towards the relief efforts in Iran as the conflict in West Asia, following attacks by the US and Israel, drags on.

One of those hens laid an egg. With a view to encouraging further contributions, the egg was auctioned, starting with a Rs 100 bid. A crowd gathered, and the bids began increasing — the egg was eventually sold for Rs 6,000.

Over the past week, the trend took off in Kargil, and small contributions, like eggs or

apples being brought in to street corners for donations, began being auctioned. One such apple fetched a price of Rs 1.05 lakh at Karkitchoo village.

Sheikh Hasnain, who studies in Iran and is currently back home in Kargil, was pres-

ent at one such auction. “It is a way of honouring the sentiment with which a person brings their household item. People are emotional, and this is their way of showing their support. So, if someone brings an apple and another pays a big

amount for it, we are showing respect for their contribution as a community,” he said.

After the killing of Iran’s then Supreme Leader, Ayatollah Ali Khamenei, on March 1, people from all parts of the Ladakh region poured out onto the streets to participate in large demonstrations against the war in West Asia.

Contributions have also poured in and continue to do so from different parts of the region. These are subsequently sent to the Iranian Embassy in New Delhi. The Karkitchoo apple is famed for its long shelf life. “The season usually ends in November, and it is rare to find apples in March. Someone had one apple left in their home

from the last season, so he brought it for the auction,” Hasnain said.

The bid started at Rs 200, and eventually, a local businessman, Ilyas, bought it for just over a lakh. “This was his way of showing respect for the person who could only bring an apple and making it count,” the student said.

Kargil has a sizable Shia Muslim population, but over the past month, contributions have poured in from all parts of Ladakh. From school children contributing money from their piggy banks to households bringing their copperware, JK and Ladakh have come together to offer financial support to Iran.

Top court refuses to stay Adani’s acquisition of JAL

THE SUPREME COURT Monday declined to interfere with the National Company Law Appellate Tribunal’s (NCLAT) March 24 interim order refusing to stay Adani Enterprises’ resolution plan to acquire Jaiprakash Associates Ltd (JAL) for Rs 14,535 crore.

A bench of Chief Justice of India Surya Kant and Justice Joyymya Bagchi, however, said that if the monitoring committee planned to take any major policy decision, it should first obtain the Tribunal’s sanction. The court noted that NCLAT had set April 10 to hear Vedanta Limited’s appeal against the National Company Law Tribunal

(NCLT) decision approving Adani’s resolution plan. “In view of the fact that the company appeals...are now listed for final hearing before NCLAT on April 10, 2026, we see no reason to entertain the impugned order of NCLAT. However, having regard to the nature of the issue and its implications, we request the NCLAT to hear the appeal on out of turn basis on the date fixed or immediately on the next working day if the arguments are not completed on the date fixed,” the bench said. “Since the Appeal is likely to be decided very soon and the interest of the appellant has been adequately protected by the NCLAT in paragraph 7 and 8 of the interim order, there seems to be no legal necessity to issue any other direction.”
