- Set measurable targets to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions and other air emissions through energy efficiency, operational improvements, use of renewable energy, and deployment of low-carbon technologies.
- Aim to achieve Net Zero emissions in line with India's climate change commitments under the Paris Agreement and strive to meet 100% of our electricity requirements from renewable sources.
- Conserve and protect biodiversity and ecosystems in and around our operational areas, collaborating with local communities and relevant stakeholders.
- Commit to environmentally sound waste management practice by prioritising reduction, reuse, recycling, and strive to achieve zero landfill waste to support a circular economy.


- Undertake environmental due diligence and impact assessments for new projects, expansions, and mergers & acquisitions.
